Leader:

The Lesson:

Today we have a story about a grown-up Jesus. Today Jesus gets to meet his cousin, John. John's work was baptizing people and getting them ready to hear Jesus' message. Jesus has not been baptized. So he comes to John and asks him to baptize him. Together they walked into the river. And when Jesus was baptized, both John and Jesus heard God say: "I am so glad you are my son!." Today's theme is "Where is the Child".

Leader: A Reading from the Gospel of Mark

John the baptizer appeared in the wilderness, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. And people from the whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem were going out to him, and were baptized by him in the river Jordan, confessing their sins. Now John was clothed with camel's hair, with a leather belt around his waist, and he ate locusts and wild honey. He proclaimed, 'The one who is more powerful than I is coming after me; I am not worthy to stoop down and untie the thong of his sandals. I have baptized you with water; but he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.' In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. And just as he was coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens torn apart and the Spirit descending like a dove on him. And a voice came from heaven, God: 'You are my Son, the Beloved; with you I am well pleased.'

Leader: The Word of the Lord.
All: Thanks be to God.

I want to tell you that Jesus did very few things all by himself. He asked others to help him. John helped Jesus today. Jesus is telling us that he is loved by God, and so are we. How could we show other people that they too are loved by God? What if we all, this week, looked for people who seemed kind of sad and we smiled at them until they could smile back?
