Children's Liturgy The First Sunday in Lent March 6, 2022: The Lamb of God

The King of love my shepherd is vs. 1, 3, 6
(The crucifer / acolyte and second teacher light candles as children sing song)
The King of love my shepherd is, whose goodness faileth never;
I nothing lack if I am his, and he is mine for ever.

Perverse and foolish oft I strayed, but yet in love he sought me, and on his shoulder gently laid, and home, rejoicing, brought me.

And so through all the length of days thy goodness faileth never: Good Shepherd, may I sing thy praise within thy house for ever.

Leader:

This is a time to collect our thoughts and give them to God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Collect for Purity:

Leader: Now is a time to calm our bodies, collect our thoughts, and give them to God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

All: Jesus, open our minds and our hearts. Amen.

Collect of the Day:

Leader: Thank you, Jesus, for giving us stories that show us that you love us. Amen.

The Lesson: All sit.

Leader: A Reading from the Gospel of John.

John 1

While Jesus was living in Galilee, his cousin, John the Baptist, was preaching out in the country of Judea. The people loved John and came to see and to hear him whenever they could. Sometimes crowds of people came to see John by the Jordan River. John would tell them, "I Baptize you on the outside with plain old water from the Jordan River, but this is nothing compared to what is coming!" John would exclaim, "The one who is coming will Baptize you with God's own Spirit! With God's Spirit, you will be changed from the inside out!" John was always talking about Jesus. He talked and talked and talked! John even Baptized Jesus in the Jordan River and the next day he said to the people around him, "Look everyone, here comes the Lamb of God!" John told everyone about how God sent Jesus to earth. He let the people know that Jesus was the Lamb of God, which meant Jesus would save everyone form the bad things they do in their lives. Day after day, whenever John saw Jesus, he told the crowds that Jesus was the Lamb of God. As People heard what John said, they became followers of Jesus too.

Leader: (After the Reading) The Word of the Lord.

All: Thanks be to God.

A Teaching (Officiant speaks 2-3 minutes)

Children's Creed: All stand.

All: We believe in God,

who made us and everything.

We believe in Jesus Christ,

who is God's son.

We believe in the Holy Spirit,

who helps us grow. Amen.

Prayers of the People: All kneel.

Leader: We pray for our clergy: Dean Beverly, and Father Eric, and everyone in the church.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for the leaders of the world, so we can live in peace.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for our families, that your love may fill our hearts.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for the boys and girls and their families who are hungry, and we give thanks for those who

help them.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for all people who are sick or sad.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for all who have died.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We ask all these things in the name of your Son, Jesus Christ.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer. Amen.

Confession: Remain kneeling and repeat after the leader.

All: Forgive us Lord,

for the things we have done

that were not kind and good. Forgive us Lord, and help us try

to do the things that we should. Amen.

Leader: Thank you God for hearing us. We know that you forgive us.

We know that Jesus loves us. We know that the Holy Spirit keeps us in God's care. Amen.

Closing Prayer

All: Oh, Lord Jesus, I praise you this day.

I give myself to you this day.

I ask you to help me this day. Amen.

The Peace All stand.

Leader: We offer each other a sign of God's peace for one another.

Leader: The peace of the Lord be always with you.

All: And also with you.

At this time Sunday School activity occurs.

Children are walked to the undercroft for art activity.

At the proper time, we will process back into the church to join our parents for the rest of the service and Holy Communion.
