Leader:

The Lesson:

This reading from the Bible was written after the birth of Jesus. In the lesson, Jesus teaches us to be more like Him

During the season of Advent we are waiting for the birth of Baby Jesus. We light a candle each week to show the birth of Jesus is coming nearer. Today we can light all four candles in our wreath. Christmas is almost here! Today's theme is "Do Not Be Afraid"

Leader: A Reading from the Gospel of Luke 1:26-38

Maybe you remember that last week we had a story about a messenger. Today, we have a story about a different kind of messenger. This messenger is an angel. Mary was a young girl about to get married. One day she was all by herself in her house when suddenly there was an angel right there in front of her. Now, I have seen lots of pictures of angels, and they always look so soft and pretty. But almost the first thing this angel said was "Don't be afraid!" The angel told Mary that God needed her to be the mother of a very special baby. And the baby should be named Jesus. Mary was very surprised, but she believed the angel and said she would do what God wanted her to do.

Leader: The Word of the Lord.
All: Thanks be to God.

Children's Creed: All stand.

All: We believe in God / Who made us and everything / We believe in Jesus Christ / Who is God's son / We believe in the Holy Spirit / Who helps us grow. Amen.

Prayers of the People: All kneel.

Leader: We pray for our clergy: Dean Beverly and everyone in the church.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for the leaders of the world, so we can live in peace.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for our families, that Your love may fill our hearts

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for the boys and girls and their families who are hungry, and give thanks for those who

help them.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for all people who are sick or sad.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for all who have died.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We ask all these things in the name of your Son, Jesus Christ.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Confession: Remain kneeling and repeat after the leader.

All: Dear God / I am sorry that I have done things, / and I should not have done. /

I ask you to forgive me / for hurting friends and those I love. /

Please help me to do better. / Thank you, God, for your love. Amen.

Leader: Thank you God for hearing us. / We know that you forgive us. /

We know that Jesus loves us. / We know that the Holy Spirit /

Keeps us in God's care. Amen.

Closing Prayer

All: Oh, Lord Jesus, I praise you this day. / I give myself to you this day /

I ask you to help me this day. Amen.

The Peace

Leader: The peace of the Lord be always with you.

All: And also with you.
