Children's Liturgy Annunciation

Song

I sing a song of the saints of God, patient and brave and true, who toiled and fought and lived and died for the Lord they loved and knew. And one was a doctor, and one was a queen, and one was a shepherdess on the green: they were all of them saints of God and I mean, God helping, to be one too.

They loved their Lord so dear, so dear, and his love made them strong; and they followed the right, for Jesus' sake, the whole of their good lives long. And one was a soldier, and one was a priest, and one was slain by a fierce wild beast; and there's not any reason no, not the least, why I shouldn't be one too.

They lived not only in ages past, there are hundreds of thousands still, the world is bright with the joyous saints who love to do Jesus' will. You can meet them in school, or in lanes, or at sea, in church, or in trains, or in shops, or at tea, for the saints of God are just folk like me, and I mean to be one too.

Leader:

This is a time to collect our thoughts and give them to God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Collect for Purity:

Leader: Now is a time to calm our bodies, collect our thoughts, and give them to God; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

All: Jesus, open our minds and our hearts. Amen.

Collect of the Day:

Leader: Thank you, Jesus, for giving us stories that show us that you love us. Amen.

Almighty God, you have surrounded us with a great cloud of witnesses: Grant that we, encouraged by the good example of your saints, may persevere in running the race that is set before us, until at last we may with *him* attain to your eternal joy; through Jesus Christ, the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. **Amen.**

The Lesson: All sit.

Leader: A Reading from the Gospel according to Luke

In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary. And he came to her and said, 'Greetings, favored one! The Lord is with you.' But she was much perplexed by his words and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. The angel said to her, 'Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you will name him Jesus. He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to him the throne of his ancestor David. He will reign over the house of Jacob for ever, and of his kingdom there will be no end.' Mary said to the angel, 'How can this be, since I am a virgin?' The angel said to her, 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be holy; he will be

called Son of God. And now, your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son; and this is the sixth month for her who was said to be barren. For nothing will be impossible with God.' Then Mary said, 'Here am I, the servant of the Lord; let it be with me according to your word.' Then the angel departed from her.

Leader: A reading from the Gospel according to Luke.

Leader: (After the Reading) The Word of the Lord.

All: Thanks be to God.

Children's Creed: All stand.

All: We believe in God, who made us and made everything. We believe in Jesus Christ,

who is God's son. We believe in the Holy Spirit, who helps us grow. Amen.

Prayers of the People: All kneel.

Leader: We pray for our clergy: Dean Beverly, Father Eric, and everyone in the church.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for the leaders of the world, so we can live in peace.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for our families, that Your love may fill our hearts.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for the boys and girls and their families who are hungry, and we give thanks for those who

help them.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for all people who are sick or sad.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for all who have died.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Leader: We ask all these things in the name of your Son, Jesus Christ.

All: Jesus, hear our prayer.

Confession: Remain kneeling and repeat after the leader.

All: Forgive us Lord, for the things we have done

that were not kind and good. Forgive us Lord, and help us try

to do the things that we should. Amen.

Leader: Thank you God for hearing us. We know that you forgive us.

We know that Jesus loves us. We know that the Holy Spirit keeps us in God's care. Amen.

Closing Prayer

All: Oh, Lord Jesus, I praise you this day. I give myself to you this day.

I ask you to help me this day. Amen.

The Peace All stand.

Leader: We offer each other a sign of God's peace for one another.

Leader: The peace of the Lord be always with you.

All: And also with you.

At this time Sunday School activity occurs.

At the proper time, we will process back into the church to join our parents for the rest of the service and Holy Communion.
