The Lesson:

Today is Easter Day so I say, "Alleluia, Christ is risen!" and you say "The Lord is risen indeed. Alleluia!" Easter is not just today. Easter Day is today and Easter Season, a celebration that lasts for seven more weeks. We want to help remind everyone that we are Easter people all the time, not just today. Today we celebrate Jesus being raised from the dead. Today's story is one of miracles and joy. Today's theme is "We Are Easter People."

Leader: A Reading from the Gospel of John.

It was early in the morning on the third day after Jesus died. The sky was pink and red with the first light of the sun. The women didn't notice the sky. They hurried to the cave that contained Jesus' body. Mary Magdalene and Mary, the mother of Jesus, led the way. Two others, Salome and Joanna, carried spices to rub on the body of Jesus. Leader: We pray for our families, that Your love may fill our hearts

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for the boys and girls and their families who are hungry, and give thanks for those who

help them.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for all people who are sick or sad.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We pray for all who have died.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Leader: We ask all these things in the name of your Son, Jesus Christ.

All: Jesus, Hear our prayer.

Confession: Remain kneeling and repeat after the leader.

All: Dear God / I am sorry that I have done things, / and I should not have done. /

I ask you to forgive me / for hurting friends and those I love. /

Please help me to do better. / Thank you, God, for your love. Amen.

Leader: Thank you God for hearing us. / We know that you forgive us. /

We know that Jesus loves us. / We know that the Holy Spirit /

Keeps us in God's care. Amen.

Closing Prayer

All: Oh, Lord Jesus, I praise you this day. / I give myself to you this day /

I ask you to help me this day. Amen.

Thank you, God, for sending Jesus to bring peace to the world.

The Peace

Leader: The peace of the Lord be always with you.

All: And also with you.
